## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A194(M) Motorway (Havannah Interchange) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - 27th June 2013

Coming into force - 4th July 2013

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A194(M) Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Sunderland, is satisfied that traffic on that Motorway and one of those connecting roads should be restricted and prohibited because slip road resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A194(M) Motorway (Havannah Interchange) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th July 2013.

## 2. In this Order:

"the southbound carriageway" means the A194(M) Motorway southbound carriageway from a point 1050 metres north of the centreline of the northern overbridge at Havannah Interchange to a point 990 metres south of the centreline of the southern overbridge at Havannah Interchange, a distance of approximately 2155 metres;

"the slip road" means the A194(M) Motorway southbound entry slip road at Havannah Interchange;

"the works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 5th July 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the southbound carriageway.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or

(c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for the purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
