**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A52 Trunk Road (Spondon, Derby) (Temporary Prohibition  
of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *9th July 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *16th July 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads, at Spondon in the City of Derby, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Spondon, Derby) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th July 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A6005/Derby Road roundabout junction;

“the trunk road” means the –  
(1) eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout and the A5111 Raynesway to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout; and  
(2) westbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout.

“the link road” means the link road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from the A5111 Raynesway;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 23rd July 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
