ROAD TRAFFIC

The A120 Trunk Road (Bradwell, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 19th August 2013

 Coming into force
 26th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A120 Trunk Road ("the A120"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Essex should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Bradwell, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 26th August 2013.

2. In this Order -

"tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the trunk road;

"the first length of trunk road" means the A120 in Bradwell from a point 50 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Riverside to a point 600 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Doghouse Road;

"the second length of trunk road" means the A120 in Bradwell from a point 350 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Bridge Hall Road to a point 150 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Doghouse Road;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"works" mean replacement of street lighting, warning sign installation, drainage repair, footway resurfacing and replacement of overhead power lines;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Tuesday 27th August 2013 and ending when the works have been completed;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 27th August 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle or to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on a length of the first length of trunk road, whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Traffic Road Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on those lengths are displayed.
 - 4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter
 - (a) or proceed in the second length of trunk road, during a works period, or
 - (b) any lay-by adjacent to the second length of trunk road, during the works period.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.
 - 6. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for traffic officer purposes,
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
 - (c) anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
 - (d) a vehicle requiring access to or from property which is accessible from, and only from, the trunk road;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (b) of this article or to any vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
