## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A120 Trunk Road (Braintree to Wix, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 7th October 2013

Coming into force - - 14th October 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A120 Trunk Road ("the A120"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Essex should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Braintree to Wix, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 14th October 2013.

### 2. In this Order -

"the first length of trunk road" means the A120 –

- (a) westbound carriageway at Wix from a point 300 metres east of its junction with Harwich Road to its junction with Harwich Road,
- (b) eastbound carriageway at Wix from a point 300 metres west of its junction with Colchester Road to its junction with Colchester Road,
- (c) eastbound and westbound carriageways from a point 400 metres east of its junction with Colchester Road, Wix to a point 650 west of its junction with the western side of the B1035/Clacton Road Roundabout, Horsley Cross,
- (d) eastbound carriageway at Bradwell between points 340 metres west and 40 metres west of its junction with Bridge Hall Road,
- (e) westbound carriageway at Bradwell between points 300 metres east and 554 metres west of its junction with Doghouse Road,
- (f) westbound carriageway at Braintree from a point 500 metres east of its junction with the eastern side of the A131/B1256 Marks Farm Roundabout to its junction with the eastern side of that roundabout,
- (g) westbound carriageway at Braintree between points 40 metres west and 200 metres west of its junction with Bridge Hall Road, and
- (h) eastbound carriageway at Braintree between points 415 metres west and 40 metres west of its junction with Bridge Hall Road;

"the second length of trunk road" means the A120 eastbound carriageway at Braintree from its junction with the eastern side of the B1018 Galleys Corner Roundabout to its junction with the western side of the A131/B1256 Marks Farm Roundabout;

"the third length of trunk road" means the A120 -

- (a) eastbound and westbound carriageways from a point 100 metres east of its junction with Colchester Road, Wix to its junction with the eastern side of the B1035/Clacton Road Roundabout, Horsley Cross, and
- (b) eastbound and westbound carriageways between its junctions with Bridge Hall Road, Braintree and Doghouse Road, Bradwell;
- "the fourth length of trunk road" means the A120 -
- (a) at Wix between its junctions with Harwich Road and Colchester Road, and
- (b) between its junctions with Bridge Hall Road, Braintree and Doghouse Road, Bradwell;
- "the roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A131/B1256 Marks Farm Roundabout, Braintree;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(a); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing and retexturing, crack sealing and renewal of road markings and road studs;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 21st October 2013 and ending when the works have been completed;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 21st October 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number and a reference to a junction is a reference to the centre line of that junction.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding
  - (a) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road,
  - (b) 50 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road, or
  - (c) 10 miles per hour on a length of the third length of trunk road, whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Traffic Road Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on those lengths are displayed.
  - **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter
    - (a) or proceed in the fourth length of trunk road or the roundabout, during a works period,
    - (b) or leave the trunk road at its junctions with Colchester Road, Goose Green and the B1035 Heath Road and Clacton Road, Horsley Cross, during a works period, or
    - (c) any lay-by adjacent to either carriageway of the A120 between Braintree and Wix, during the works period.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

- 6. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
  - (c) anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
  - (d) a vehicle requiring access to or from property which is accessible from, and only from, the trunk road;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (b) of this article or to any vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
