## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A47 Trunk Road (Oversley Lodge Roundabout to New Cut Roundabout Thorney City of Peterborough) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road ("the A47"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the City of Peterborough should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Oversley Lodge Roundabout to New Cut Roundabout Thorney City of Peterborough) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 21st October 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road" means the A47 at Thorney between its junctions with the eastern side of the B1167 Oversley Lodge Roundabout and the western side of the B1167 New Cut Roundabout, excluding the circulatory carriageway of the B1040 Station Road Roundabout;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"works" mean renewal of road markings and road studs;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 28th October 2013 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 28th October 2013 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter -

- (a) or proceed in the trunk road, during a works period, or
- (b) any lay-by adjacent to the trunk road, during the works period.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
