## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A120 Trunk Road (Ardleigh Crown Interchange, Colchester Essex) Eastbound Link Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2013

Made - - - - 28th October 2013

Coming into force - - 4th November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A120 Trunk Road ("the A120") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Ardleigh Crown Interchange, Colchester Essex) Eastbound Link Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th November 2013.

## 2. In this Order –

"the link road" means the length of A120 that connects the A12 northbound to the A120 eastbound at the A12/A120/A1232 Ardleigh Crown Interchange;

"works" mean parapet and barrier repair works to the north side of Kilnwood Bridge;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 11th November 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
