ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway and A45 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 16) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made---Ist November 2013Coming into force--8th November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and the A45 Trunk Road ("the A45"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and that trunk road, at Upper Heyford, in the County of Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway and A45 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 16) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 8th November 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway"	means the northbound carriageway of the M1 between its junctions with the exit slip road and the entry slip roads at Junction 16;
"the roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A45, A4500 and the slip roads leading to and from the M1 at Junction 16;
"part of the roundabout"	means that part of the roundabout between its junction with the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M1 and its junction with the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M1;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 11th November 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway or part of the roundabout.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (c) being used by or with the permission of a traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) being used in connection with the said works.
