ROAD TRAFFIC

The M57 Motorway (Junction 3 Northbound Entry and Southbound Exit Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 27th February 2013

Coming into force - - 17th March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M57 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in the District of Knowsley in the County of Merseyside should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M57 Motorway (Junction 3 Northbound Entry and Southbound Exit Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th March 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M57 Motorway;

"works" means carriageway patching and road marking works

"the works period" means a period starting at 2000 hours on Monday 18 March and ending at 0600 hours on Monday 18 March 2013. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the first slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 3;

"the second slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 3;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first and second slip roads.

4.	The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent
	as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services,
	vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
	proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in
	uniform.
