**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A1 Trunk Road (Blyth, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary  
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *8th February 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *15th February 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Blyth in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Blyth, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 15th February 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the first length of trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A1 from the centreline of Common Lane overbridge to the centreline of the overbridge carrying the link road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A1 from the A634 Spital Road (known as Blyth flyover);

“the second length of trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A1 from its junction with the exit slip road at A1(M) Junction 34 to its junction with the link road leading from the A634 Spital Road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 18th February 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road.

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

(a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

(b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and

(c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
