ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 7 to Junction 9) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway ("the A1(M)") is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Hertfordshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 7 to Junction 9) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 31st January 2014.

2. In this Order "tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the road markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the motorway.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 3rd February 2014 and ending when the works have been completed, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the A1(M) –

- (a) southbound carriageway between points 1300 metres south and 2800 metres south of the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 9,
- (b) southbound carriageway between points 560 metres south and 2060 metres south of the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 7,
- (c) northbound carriageway between points 850 metres south and 650 metres north of the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 7,
- (d) northbound carriageway between points 3350 metres south and 1850 metres south of the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 7, and
- (e) northbound carriageway between points 5550 metres south and 4050 metres south of the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 7.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes or a vehicle falling within regulation
