ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (M1 Junctions 21 to 20) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014

 12th August 2014

 Coming into force
 19th August 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the County of Leicestershire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (M1 Junctions 21 to 20) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 19th August 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the southbound carriageway of the M1 from a point

400 metres south of the centreline of Cosby Lane overbridge near Broughton Astley for a distance of 2.8

kilometres in a southerly direction;

"the works period" means the period starting at 08:00 hours on Tuesday 26th

August 2014 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle:
 - a. being used for special forces purposes;
 - b. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - c. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
