## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

# The A23 Trunk Road (A2300 Jobs Lane, Hickstead) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 8th September 2014

Coming into force - - 27th September 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A23 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that Trunk Road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A23 Trunk Road (A2300 Jobs Lane, Hickstead) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th September 2014.

#### 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A23 Trunk Road in the County of West Sussex;

"the length of carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the A23 between points 640 metres north and 142 metres south of the centre line of the A23 (A2300/Job's Lane overbridge);

"works" means structural and stability earthworks, drainage and all associated works; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 29th September 2014 or on any subsequent day until 26th March 2016.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of carriageway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(**b**) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
