ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 and M42 Motorways (M6 Junction 4, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 24th November 2014

Coming into force - 1st December 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway ("the M6"), the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 and M42 Motorways (M6 Junction 4, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 1st December 2014.

2. In this Order -

"the slip road" means the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of

the M6 at Junction 4;

"the link road" means the link road leading from the northbound carriageway of

the M42 to the southbound carriageway of the M6 (M6 Junction

4);

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 8th

December and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road or the link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
