**CIVIL AVIATION**

**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth)  
Regulations 2015**

*Made* - - - - *14th April 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *20th August 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Bournemouth, Dorset, by reason of flying displays that are scheduled to take place there during the period from 20th to 23rd August 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009<sup>(a)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bournemouth) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 20th August 2015.

**Interpretation**

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time<sup>(b)</sup>.

**Restricted airspace**

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (3)—

- (a) between 1200 hours and 2000 hours on 20th August 2015,
- (b) between 1100 hours and 2000 hours on 21st and 22nd August 2015, and
- (c) between 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 23rd August 2015,

no aircraft is to fly below 5,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by straight lines joining successively the points referred to in paragraph (2).

(2) The points mentioned in paragraph (1) are—

- (a) 504304N 0015636W,
- (b) 504405N 0014703W,
- (c) 504016N 0014604W,
- (d) 503914N 0015537W, and
- (e) 504304N 0015636W.

(a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.

(b) In these Regulations Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

- (3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying—
- (a) in accordance with a clearance issued by the air traffic control unit at either Bournemouth Airport or Southampton Airport, or
  - (b) with the permission of the Bournemouth Air Festival flying display director.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of the seafront at Bournemouth, Dorset during the Bournemouth Air Festival which will take place between 20th and 23rd August 2015. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. Accordingly, the Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety and security and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
