**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M60, M61, M62, M66 and M602 Motorways (Manchester Smart Motorway Scheme) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015**

*Made* - - - - *20th January 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *22nd January 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60, M61, M62, M66 and M602 Motorways, their slip and link roads and circulatory carriageways, is satisfied that traffic on sections of those motorways, on those slip and link roads and circulatory carriageways in the Districts of Manchester, Salford, Trafford, Bury, Rochdale and Bolton in Greater Manchester should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) and 15(2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and regulation 16(2) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M60, M61, M62, M66 and M602 Motorways (Manchester Smart Motorway Scheme) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 22nd January 2015.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M60, M61, M62, M66 or M602 Motorways;

“works” means works associated with the Manchester Smart Motorway Scheme;

“a reference to a numbered column is to the column in the Schedule to this Order bearing that number;

“the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road” means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

“the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road” means the first point where the slip road joins the carriageway of the motorway;

“entry slip road” means a slip road leading to the motorway;

“exit slip road” means a slip road leading from the motorway;

“link road” means a link road between motorways;

“distributor road” means the distributor road alongside the M60 anticlockwise carriageway between Junction 12 and Junction 11;

“the circulatory carriageway” means the circulatory carriageway of the M60/M62 roundabout at Junction 18;

“hardshoulder” has the meaning given in regulation 3(1)(e) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(a);

“overall width” has the meaning given in regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986(b);

“the first works period” means a period starting at 0001 hours on Friday 23rd January 2015 and ending at 2359 hours on Wednesday 31st January 2018;

“the second works period” means periods overnight between 2100 hours and 0600 hours during a period starting on Friday 23rd January 2015 and ending on Wednesday 31st January 2018.

**3.** The M60, M62, M61 and M602 Motorways (Manchester Smart Motorway Scheme) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014(c) is hereby revoked.

**4.** Subject to as mentioned in articles 9 and 10 of this Order, during the first works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the lengths of carriageway, slip roads, link roads and circulatory carriageway described in the Schedule to this Order, at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.

**5.** Subject as mentioned in article 9 of this Order, during the first works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle with an overall width exceeding 3.25 metres (10 feet 6 inches), 3 metres (9 feet 8 inches) or 2.75 metres (9 feet 0 inches) to enter or proceed in a lane of the lengths of carriageway, slip roads, link roads, circulatory carriageway and adjacent lengths of hardshoulder described in the Schedule to this Order, as indicated by traffic signs.

**6.** Subject to as mentioned in article 9 of this Order, during the second works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the lengths of carriageway, slip roads, link roads and circulatory carriageway described in the Schedule to this Order.

**7.** The provisions of regulations 5 and (in so far as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982 are suspended in relation to the adjacent lengths of hardshoulder defined in the Schedule to this Order at such times and to such extent as may be indicated by traffic signs; and in this article, “hardshoulder” has the meaning given in regulation 3(1)(e) of those Regulations.

**8.** The Secretary of State is satisfied that the execution of the said works will take longer than a period of 18 months starting on the date when this Order comes into force.

**9.** The provisions of articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.

And nothing in articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by traffic officers.

**10.** No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011<sup>(a)</sup> when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

## SCHEDULE

Articles 4, 5, 6 & 7

<b>Description of lengths of carriageway, slip roads, link roads, circulatory carriageway and adjacent lengths of hardshoulder</b>
<b>1. M60 clockwise and anticlockwise</b>  The M60 clockwise and anticlockwise carriageways between the M60 Junction 7 and M60/M62 Junction 18 from a point at the middle of the M60 Bridgewater Canal Bridge at Junction 7 through to a point 300 metres east of the tip of the nosing of the M60 Junction 18 exit slip road.
<b>2. M62 eastbound and westbound</b>  The M62 eastbound and westbound carriageways between the M60/M62 Junction 18 and the M62 Junction 20 from a point 300 metres east of the tip of the nosing of the M60 Junction 18 exit slip road to a point in the middle of Broad Lane B6194 overbridges between Junction 20 and Junction 21.
<b>3. The M60 Junction 7 Slip Roads</b>  The M60 Junction 7 clockwise entry slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 7 anticlockwise exit slip road.
<b>4. The M60 Junction 8 Slip Roads</b>  The full length of the M60 Junction 8 clockwise entry slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 8 anticlockwise exit slip road.
<b>5. The M60 Junction 9 Slip Roads</b>  The full length of the M60 Junction 9 clockwise exit slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 9 clockwise entry slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 9 anticlockwise exit slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 9 anticlockwise entry slip road.
<b>6. The M60 Junction 10 Slip Roads</b>  The full length of the M60 Junction 10 clockwise exit slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 10 clockwise entry slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 10 anticlockwise exit slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 10 anticlockwise entry slip road.
<b>7. The M60 Junction 11 Slip Roads</b>  The full length of the M60 Junction 11 clockwise exit slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 11 clockwise entry slip road.  The full length of the M60 Junction 11 anticlockwise exit slip road to the distributor road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 11 anticlockwise entry slip road.

#### **8. The M60 Junction 12 Link Roads**

The full length of the M60 Junction 12 anticlockwise link road onto the M62 westbound.

The full length of the M60 Junction 12 anticlockwise link road onto the M602 eastbound.

The full length of the M60 Junction 12 clockwise link road onto the M62 westbound.

The full length of the M60 Junction 12 clockwise link road onto the M602 eastbound.

The full length of the M602 westbound link road onto the M60 anticlockwise distributor road.

The full length of the M60 anticlockwise distributor road between the M602 westbound link road and the Junction 11 exit to the A57.

The full length of the M602 westbound link road onto the M60 clockwise.

The full length of the M62 eastbound link road onto the M60 clockwise.

The full length of the M62 eastbound link road onto the M60 anticlockwise.

#### **9. The M62/M602 Eastbound**

The M62/M602 eastbound carriageways from a point at the middle of the M62 Barton Moss Railway Bridge to a point at the middle of the M602 Bridgewater Canal Bridge.

#### **10. The M602/M62 Westbound**

The M602/M62 westbound carriageways from a point at the middle of the M602 Bridgewater Canal Bridge to a point at the middle of the M62 Barton Moss Railway Bridge.

#### **11. The M60 Junction 13 Slip Roads**

The full length of the M60 Junction 13 clockwise exit slip road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 13 clockwise entry slip road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 13 anticlockwise exit slip road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 13 anticlockwise entry slip road.

#### **12. The M60 Junction 14/A580 Link Roads**

The link road from the A580 East Lancashire Road to the M60 clockwise from a point at the middle of the A6 Manchester Road underbridge to the point where it meets the M60 clockwise carriageway.

The M60 Junction 14 anticlockwise exit slip road from the start of the slip road to a point at the middle of the A6 Manchester Road underbridge.

#### **13. The M60 Junction 15 Link Roads to and from the M61**

The M60 Junction 15 clockwise link road onto the M61 northbound from the start of the link road at the Junction 15 exit to a point at the middle of Ryders Farm overbridge.

The M60 Junction 15 anticlockwise exit slip road onto the M61 northbound, from a point at the start of the link road at the Junction 15 exit, to a point at the middle of Ryders Farm overbridge.

The M61 southbound carriageway approach to the M60 clockwise and anticlockwise, from a point at the middle of Moss Farm footbridge to the end of the link roads where the M61 southbound joins the M60 clockwise and the M60 anticlockwise.

**14. The M60 Junction 16 Slip Roads**

The full length of the M60 Junction 16 clockwise entry slip road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 16 anticlockwise exit slip road.

**15. The M60 Junction 17 Slip Roads**

The full length of the M60 Junction 17 clockwise exit slip road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 17 clockwise entry slip road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 17 anticlockwise exit slip road.

The full length of the M60 Junction 17 anticlockwise entry slip road.

**16. The M66 Northbound and Southbound/M60 Clockwise and Anticlockwise Carriageways** from a point at the middle of the M66 Hills Lane overbridge to a point at the middle of the M60 Old Hall Lane footbridge.

**The M60/M62 Junction 18 and M66 Junction 4 Slip Roads, link roads and circulatory carriageway** – the full length of all entry and exit slip roads, link roads and the circulatory carriageway.

**17. The M62 Birch Motorway Service Area**

The full length of the eastbound exit slip road to Birch Services.

The full length of the eastbound entry slip road from Birch Services.

The full length of the westbound exit slip road to Birch Services.

The full length of the westbound entry slip road from Birch Services.

**18. The M62 Junction 19 Slip Roads**

The full length of the M62 Junction 19 eastbound exit slip road.

The full length of the M62 Junction 19 eastbound entry slip road.

The full length of the M62 Junction 19 westbound exit slip road.

The full length of the M62 Junction 19 westbound entry slip road.

**19. The M62 Junction 20 Slip Roads**

The full length of the M62 Junction 20 eastbound exit slip road.

The full length of the M62 Junction 20 eastbound entry slip road.

The full length of the M62 Junction 20 westbound exit slip road.

The full length of the M62 Junction 20 westbound entry slip road.
