The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leicester) (No. 2) (Emergency) Regulations 2018

The Secretary of State for a reason affecting the public interest deems it necessary to restrict flying in the vicinity of the area specified in the Schedule by reason of an emergency having arisen in that area.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leicester) (No. 2) (Emergency) Regulations 2018 and come into force with immediate effect.

Restricted airspace

2. No aircraft is to fly below Flight Level 105 over the area specified in Column 1 of the Schedule, being an area bounded by a circle of the radius specified in Column 2 and centred on the position specified in Column 3.

3. These Regulations do not apply to any aircraft—

- (1) flying in the service of
 - (a) the National Police Air Service,
 - (b) the Helicopter Emergency Medical Services,
 - (c) the Maritime and Coastguard Agency, or
 - (d) the Air Accidents Investigation Branch, or

(2) making an instrument approach to, or instrument departure from, East Midlands Airport whist under the control of the air traffic units at East Midlands Airport or London Terminal Control, Swanwick, or

(3) flying with the permission of the Leicestershire Police Silver Commander.
