The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stubbs Walden, Doncaster) (Emergency) Regulations 2024

The Secretary of State for a reason affecting the public interest deems it necessary to restrict flying in the area specified in the Schedule by reason of an emergency having arisen in that area.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stubbs Walden, Doncaster) (Emergency) Regulations 2024 and they come into force on 20th November 2024.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 the times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(b).

Restricted airspace

3. Beginning at 0800 hours on 20th November 2024 no aircraft is to fly below 2,500 feet above mean sea level over the area specified in Column 1 of the Schedule, being an area bounded by a circle of the radius specified in Column 2 and centred on the position specified in Column 3.

4. These Regulations do not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with a permission from North Yorkshire Police.
