The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Birmingham) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2025

Made - - - at 12.15 p.m. on 27th January 2025

Coming into force with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has decided that it is no longer considered necessary in the public interest to restrict the flying of unmanned aircraft in the area specified in the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Birmingham) (Emergency) Regulations 2025.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order $2016(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Birmingham) (Emergency) (Revocation) Regulations 2025 and they come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Birmingham) (Emergency) Regulations 2025(**b**) are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations revoke the statutory instrument which imposed emergency restrictions on the flying of unmanned aircraft in the vicinity of Birmingham (S.I. 2025/61) as the emergency in question has now passed.
