Your Excellency,

Senhor Embaixador.

Rio de Janeiro, September 19, 1957.

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement constituted by the Exchange of Notes of the 16th of August, 1955,(¹) between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the United States of Brazil regarding the continuance in force of certain Articles of the Trade and Payments Agreement which was signed at Rio de Janeiro on the 21st of May, 1948,(²) and to propose that Articles 15 and 19 (a) to (d) of the Agreement shall continue in force for a further period of one year from the 1st of October, 1957, to the 30th of September, 1958, both dates inclusive.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United States of Brazil, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter.

Com referência à troca de notas efetuada em 16 de agôsto de 1955, entre o Ministério das Relações Exteriores e a Embaixada de Sua Majestade Britânica, que prorrogou certos artigos do Acôrdo de Comércio e de Pagamentos, assinado no Rio de Janeiro, em 21 de maio de 1948, tenho a honra de comunicar a Vossa Excelência que o Govêrno brasileiro concorda em prorrrogar, pelo período adicional de um ano, de 1° de outubro de 1957 a 30 de setembro de 1958, inclusive, a vigência dos artigos XV e XIX (a) até (d) do referido Acôrdo.

2. Esta nota e a de Vossa Excelência, da mesma data e de idêntico teor, constituem acôrdo formal entro nossos dois Governos sôbre o assunto.

With reference to the Exchange of Notes which took place on the 16th of August, 1955, between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy, which extended certain articles of the Trade and Payments Agreement signed in Rio de Janeiro on the 21st of May, 1948, 1 have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Brazilian Government agrees to extend, for the additional period of one year, from the 1st of October, 1957, to the 30th of September, 1958, inclusive, the provisions of articles XV and XIX (a) to (d) of the Agreement referred to.

2. This Note, and that of Your Excellency, of the same tenor and date. constitute a formal agreement between our two Governments in the matter.
