I have the honour to refer to the Agreement constituted by Notes exchanged on 22 April and 19 May 1977(<sup>1</sup>) between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the European Centre for Medium-Range Weather Forecasts, concerning social security arrangements for staff at the Centre. I now have the honour to propose that the exemptions accorded by that Agreement to the staff members of the Centre who are not citizens of the United Kingdom and Colonies or permanently resident in the United Kingdom shall also be accorded, under the conditions laid down in that Agreement, to staff members of the Centre who are citizens of the United Kingdom and Colonies or permanently resident in the United Kingdom and Colonies or permanently resident in the United Kingdom.
