**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A465 Trunk Road (Aberdulais  
Interchange, Neath Port Talbot)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles,  
Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2013**

*Made* 20 September 2013

*Coming into force* 27 September 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Neath – Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 27 September 2013 and its title is The A465 Trunk Road (Aberdulais Interchange, Neath Port Talbot) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2013.

**2.—(1)** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the:

- i. the entire length of the westbound exit slip road at Aberdulais Interchange in the County Borough of Neath Port Talbot;

ii. the entire length of the westbound entry slip road at Aberdulais Interchange in the County Borough of Neath Port Talbot;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 21:00 hours on 27 September 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibitions**

**3.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

**4.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle in the lengths of the trunk road.

**5.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

### **Application**

**6.** The provisions of article 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

**7.** The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.
