The A5 Trunk Road (Coed y Gloddfa, Conwy) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2015

Made 6 January 2015

Coming into force 12 January 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road...

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1.This Order comes into force on 12 January 2015. The title to this Order is The A5 Trunk Road (Coed y Gloddfa, Conwy) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2015.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the trunk road at Coed y Gloddfa, west of Pentrefoelas, in the County Borough of Conwy, which extends from a point 150 metres east of its junction with the unclassified road leading to the dewlling known as Padog to a point 660 metres west of its junction with the B4407;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 07:00 hours on 12 January 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Restrictions and Prohibitions

- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road.
- **5.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road.
- **6.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road, during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

Application

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibitions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
