ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A458 Trunk Road (East of Buttington Roundabout, Buttington, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2017

Made 17 January 2017

Coming into force 23 January 2017

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Shrewsbury – Dolgellau Trunk Road (A458) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 23 January 2017 and its title is The A458 Trunk Road (East of Buttington Roundabout, Buttington, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2017.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services, for winter maintenance and in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length(s) of the trunk road" ("y darn(au) o'r gefnffordd") means the following lengths of the trunk road in the County of Powys:

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006, these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

- i. the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the eastern side of Buttington Roundabout to a point 325 metres east of that junction;
- ii. the length of the trunk road that extends from a point 140 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with the B4388 to a point 10 metres east of that junction;
- iii. the length of the trunk road that extends from a point 10 metres south-west of the centre-point of its junction with the C2039 Criggion Lane to a point 568 metres south-west of the centre-point of its junction with the U2252 near The Breidden Inn;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 23 January 2017 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
