**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A487 Trunk Road (East Street,  
Bridge Street & West Street,  
Newport, Pembrokeshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)  
Order 2019

*Made* 13 May 2019

*Coming into force* 19 May 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title, Commencement and Interpretation**

**1.** The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (East Street, Bridge Street & West Street, Newport, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 19 May 2019.

**2.** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor Trunk Road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 07:00 hours on 19 May 2019 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

### **Prohibition**

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road known as East Street, Bridge Street and West Street at Newport, Pembrokeshire that extends from a point 185 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the U3447 (known as Feidr Bentick) to a point 1.11 kilometres west of that junction.

### **Application**

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
