The A470 Trunk Road (Rhayader,
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles, Cyclists & Equestrians)
Order 2022

Made 1 March 2022

Coming into force 5 March 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (Rhayader, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Equestrians) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 5 March 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A470 Cardiff to Llangurig trunk road that

extends from a point 25 metres south-east of the centre-point of its junction with the B4518 St Harmon Road to a point 200 metres north-west of the centre-point of the vehicular access to Wyeside Caravan & Camping Park at Rhayader, Powys;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 07:00 hours on 5 March 2022 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.

5. No equestrian may, during the works period, ride or lead any horse on the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
