ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A487 & A40 Trunk Roads (Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024

Made 17 December 2024

Coming into force 31 December 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 trunk road and the relevant length of the A40 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk roads should be prohibited by reason of a relevant event, namely the Fishguard & Goodwick Community Events Association's Annual New Year's Eve Street Festival, being held on or near the roads.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A487 & A40 Trunk Roads (Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 31 December 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"event period" ("cyfnod y digwyddiad") means the period commencing at 17:00 hours on 31 December 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means—

- (i) any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance services purposes;
- (ii) any vehicle being used in connection with works to the road or lighting or traffic signs or emergency works to any sewer or to any main or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or telecommunications in, or in any land adjacent to, a length of road concerned;
- (iii) any vehicle used by an authorised event official in support of and for reasons of the safety of the relevant event;

"the trunk roads" ("*y cefnffyrdd*") means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road and the A40 London to Fishguard trunk road.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the event period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 2 days.

SCHEDULE

The length of the A487 Main Street that extends from its junction with Fishguard Square to its junction with Hamilton Street.

The length of the A487 West Street that extends from its junction with Fishguard Square to its junction with the A487 Ffordd yr Efail.

The length of the A40 High Street that extends from its junction with Fishguard Square to its junction with the A487 Ffordd yr Efail.

The lengths of the loading bays located opposite number 10 West Street, outside the Abergwaun Hotel and opposite the premises known as Silver Stoves, High Street.
