**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A40 Trunk Road (Leys Bends,  
Monmouthshire) (Temporary  
Traffic Prohibitions and  
Restrictions) Order 2024**

*Made* 18 September 2024

*Coming into force* 30 September 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A40 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and/or restricted because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup>, make this Order.

**Title and commencement**

1. The title of this Order is the A40 Trunk Road (Leys Bends, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 30 September 2024.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

- (a) any vehicle being used by the emergency services for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act

1984(1) or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

(b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—

(i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or

(ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

“special forces” (*“lluoedd arbennig”*) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director;

“the trunk road” (*“y gefnffordd”*) means the A40 Newport to Worcester trunk road;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means intermittent periods commencing at 20:00 hours on 30 September 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

### **Prohibitions and restrictions**

**3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the eastbound carriageway of the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

**4.** Whilst movement of traffic is, by article 3, prohibited in the eastbound carriageway, but pursuant to article 8, not prohibited in the westbound carriageway, no person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the offside lane of the westbound carriageway of the trunk road in any direction other than eastwards.

**5.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle with a width in excess of 2.9 metres on the contraflow specified in article 4 to this Order.

**6.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the

lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

7. No person may, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

### **Application**

8.—(1) The prohibitions and restrictions in articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

(2) No speed limits imposed by this Order apply to an exempted vehicle.

### **Suspensions**

9. Any statutory provisions restricting the speed of vehicles on the relevant lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order are suspended during such times as the restriction specified in article 7 is in operation.

### **Duration of this Order**

10. The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### **Contraflow**

The length of the A40 trunk road from a point 800 metres northeast of its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Dixton Roundabout to the Wales/England border.

## **SCHEDULE 2**

### **Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

The length of the A40 northeastbound carriageway from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Dixton Roundabout to the Wales/England border,

(Local Access will be permitted from Raglan Junction to Dixton Roundabout).

The length of the A40 southwestbound carriageway from the Wales/England border to its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Dixton Roundabout.

The length of the A40 southwestbound layby at a point 1000 metres northeast of the junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Dixton Roundabout.

The length of the A40 northeastbound layby at a point 525 metres east of the junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Dixton Roundabout.

**SCHEDULE 3**  
**Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit**

The length of the A40 northeastbound carriageway from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Dixton Roundabout to the Wales/England border.

The length of the A40 southwestbound carriageway from the Wales/England border to its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Dixton Roundabout.
