**The A494 Trunk Road (Rhos Street,
Ruthin, Denbighshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists &
Pedestrians) Order 2025**

Made 6 January 2025

Coming into force 12 January 2025

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A494 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A494 Trunk Road (Rhos Street, Ruthin, Denbighshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2025 and it comes into force on 12 January 2025.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services and in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“specified length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the A494

Dolgellau to South of Birkenhead Trunk Road known as Rhos Street that commences from its junction with the side road known as Haulfryn to where the A494 Trunk Road becomes known as Wernfechan;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 07:00 hours on 12 January 2025 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the specified length of the trunk road.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the specified length of the trunk road.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the specified length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
