The A477 Trunk Road (Sageston Roundabout, Pembrokeshire) (Derestriction) Order 2025

Made 3 March 2025

Coming into force 7 March 2025

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A477 trunk road, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted with the Chief Officer of Dyfed-Powys Police and given public notice of their intention to make this Order in accordance with regulations 5(1) and 6(1) of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1990(2).

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A477 Trunk Road (Sageston Roundabout, Pembrokeshire) (Derestriction) Order 2025 and this Order comes into force on 7 March 2025.

Interpretation

2. In this Order "the trunk road" ("*y gefnffordd*") means the A477 St Clears to Pembroke Dock trunk road.

Desrestriction

3. The length of the trunk road that comprises the Sageston Roundabout circulatory carriageway at Sageston in the County of Pembrokeshire shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
